PUBLIC NOTICE OF MUNICIPAL ELECTIONS

Notice is given to electors in Montréal that:

1. Nominations for the office of mayor of Montréal, 18 offices of borough mayor, 46 offices of city councillor, and 38 offices of borough councillor, in the boroughs and electoral districts listed below, are now open.
2. The nomination papers for the offices of mayor of Montréal, borough mayor, city councillor and borough councillor are available at the Office of the Returning Officer, at 155, rue Notre-Dame East, Montréal, from 9 a.m. to 4:30 p.m., Monday through Friday, as well as at the Elections Montréal points of service in the boroughs mentioned below and at elections.montreal.ca.

Any declaration of candidacy for the position of mayor of the city of Montreal, as a candidate of an authorized party or as an independent candidate, must be filed with the office of the returning officer, at the above address, between **September 17 and October 1, 2021, no later than 4:30 pm**. The returning officer Me Emmanuel Tani-Moore and Mr. Charles-André Goulet, as deputy, may receive these declarations of candidacy.

All nomination papers for the offices of **borough mayor, city councillor and borough councillor**, as the candidate of an authorized party or as an independent candidate, must be filed with the

assistant returning officer of the borough where the candidate is running for office, at the address shown below, between **September 17p.m. on October 1, 2021, no later than 4:30 pm**. I have also appointed, for each borough Mr. Charles-André Goulet, as assistant returning officer, as well as the assistant returning officers listed below, in their respective boroughs, to receive nomination papers.

Take note that on Friday, October 1, last day to fill the nomination papers, offices will be open from 9 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. without interruption.

I have also designated, for each borough, Mr. Charles-André Goulet, as deputy, as well as the assistants mentioned below in their respective borough to receive these declarations of candidacy.

3. If more than one candidate is running for the same office, a poll will be held on Saturday november 6 and Sunday, November 7, from 9:30 a.m. to 8 p.m. and an advance poll will be held on Saturday, October 30 and Sunday, October 31, from 9:30 a.m. to 8 p.m. Other special measures are being taken to ensure that everyone is able to exercise his or her right to vote. Make sure you are informed.
4. I have appointed Mr. Charles-André Goulet as election clerk.

Exceptional measures related to the health situation (vote by mail – COVID-19)

You can vote by mail if you are in one of the following situations:

- You are domiciled in an eligible health establishment
- You are domiciled in the municipality, but are unable to travel for health reasons or you are a caregiver domiciled at the same address as such a person.
- Between Sunday October 17, 2021 and Wednesday October 27, 2021 you must comply with an order or a recommendation for isolation from public health authorities because you:
 - returned from a trip abroad within the last 14 days;
 - were diagnosed with COVID-19 and you are still considered a carrier of the disease;
 - are showing COVID-19 symptoms;
 - have been in contact with a suspected, probable or confirmed case of COVID-19 within the last 14 days;
 - are waiting for a COVID-19 test result.

To vote by mail, eligible electors must make a verbal or written request to the returning officer no later than October 27, 2021. The ballot papers for voting by mail will be sent as of 11 October. If you are registered to vote by mail and you have not received your ballot papers a few days after their sending, you can contact the returning officer to obtain new ones.

Ballot papers must be received at the office of the returning officer no later than Friday, November 5, 2021, at 4:30 p.m. If you are requesting to vote by mail because you must comply with an order or a recommendation from public health authorities to isolate, your request will be valid for the current poll only. If you are in a situation other than those above, your application will be valid for the current poll and any recommended proceedings arising from this election.
