To work for the elections, one must:



- be at least 16 years old
- possess a social insurance number
- have access to a valid email address

The work days are:



October 30th et 31st
and/or
November 6th and 7th

13 000 paid positions available



Why working for the municipal elections?

Working at an election is a unique opportunity: to contribute to Montréal's democratic life; to familiarize yourself with the electoral process and to get involved in your community!

What is the payment offered?

Depending on the position: between 343 \$ and 650 \$ per weekend, as a lump sum package.

Will it affect my last-resort financial assistance or my student financial assistance benefits?

When determining your need for financial assistance, the income earned during elections are included as "not considered income".
